Change in installed capacity from brand-wise to single capacity from M/s. Pernod Ricard India Pvt. Ltd.,

**d) Other Information :-**

M/s. Pernod Ricard India Pvt. Ltd., Nagpur were issued LOP No. PER:SEEPZ-SEZ/IA-II/12/02/2015-16/10802 dated 03.05.2016 at 147, Kekatpur Davargaon to Mozari Road, taluka & District Amravati, Maharashtra - 444 901 for manufacture and export of following items :-

| Item of Manufacture   | Capacity        |
|-----------------------|-----------------|
| IMFL (Blenders Pride) | 2,37,000 Cases  |
| IMFL (Imperial Blue)  | 1,18,000 Cases  |
| IMFL (Royal Stag)     | 14,54,000 Cases |

The unit vide letter dated 03.05.2016 has intimated the following :-

- i) They have been granted the approval to produce and export IMFL brands viz. Blenders Pride, Royal Stag and Imperial Blue with respective volumes as 2,37,000, 14,54,000 & 1,18,000 cases of 9 liters, aggregating 18 lakhs cases by 2019-20 from EOU.
- ii) The ceiling on the existing brands will limit flexibility of leveraging the brand mix, also there are some other brands in Pernod Ricard's repertoire which could be exported given the favorable business environment foreseen.
- iii) The cap placed on the brands that can be exported will then prohibit them from achieving export potential of the unit to the maximum.
- iv) They have requested to kindly review the condition on brand wise caps and allow them to manufacture and export their existing brands i.e. Blenders Pride, Royal Stag and Imperial Blue along with any other future brands from the unit to the extent of maximum installed capacity.

- v) This will enable them to respond to the market better, have an optimum product mix and achieve better value addition.
- vi) They need for reinstallation of the pipeline to supply Grain Neutral Spirit (GNS), one of the raw materials from the adjacent distillery separated by a boundary walls. The supply of GNS would be under the State Excise supervision with quantities monitored and recoded by a measuring instrument.
- vii) The reinstatement of the pipeline will facilitate operations by ensuring uninterrupted supply of an essential raw material.

As regards change in installed capacity from brand wise to single capacity, the proposal is placed before the Unit Approval Committee for consideration.
