1. Confirmation of Minutes of the 10th Meeting (2016 Series) held on 13.02.2017.

The Unit Approval Committee ratified the minutes of its 10th meeting held on 13.02.2017.

2. M/s. Jay Precision Products Pvt. Ltd.

The Committee noted that the jurisdictional Central Excise Authority has informed that the premises is not secured by roof and full wall hence not suitable for bonded warehouse. The representative of applicant company stated that the roof is already covered and presented the photograph. As regards, side wall it is stated that the same has been kept open for installation of machineries and after installation the same will be covered.

The Committee also noted that the Office of DC, Noida SEZ has informed that the applicant company and its directors are in the list of fraudulent units. The representative of applicant company stated that they do not have any SEZ/EOU units under Noida SEZ jurisdiction. This might be a mistake on their part. The representative of applicant company also stated that they are the status holder and no cases are contemplated against them or its directors.

The Committee after detailed deliberation approved the proposal subject to condition that Capital Goods will be allowed. However, the Raw Material will be allowed only after Central Excise is satisfied on securing of bonding. Also, a report from O/o DC Noida SEZ may again be obtained before granting LOP. The Noida SEZ on 17.03.2017 has confirmed that the said unit does not fall in the list of fraudulent units.

3. M/s. Renishaw Metrology Systems Ltd.

After detailed deliberation the Committee approved the proposal of M/s. Renishaw Metrology Systems Ltd., for addition of new product viz. "Additive Manufacturing Machine and Parts thereof" in the LOP.

4. M/s. Parekh Aluminex Ltd.

The representative of the unit did not attend the meeting. The Committee deferred the matter.
