I. Confirmation of Minutes of the 4th Meeting (2015 Series) held on 05.06.2015.

The Unit Approval Committee ratified the minutes of its 4th meeting held on 05.06.2015.

1. M/s. Perrigo API India Pvt. Ltd.

The representative of the unit did not attend the meeting. The Committee deferred the matter.

2. M/s. Renishaw Metrology Systems Ltd.

After detailed deliberation the Committee approved the proposal of addition of new item viz. Equator Enclosure Assembly and Equator Rack Assembly with revision of projection for remaining period of 2 years i.e. 2015-16 to 2016-17.

3. M/s. Ravechi Floritech Pvt. Ltd.

The representative of the unit informed that they have now started exporting the cut-flowers and they have also brought the Capital Goods in working condition and all efforts are on to effect the export from their farm. The jurisdictional Central Excise Authority was asked to inspect the location of the unit to ascertain the present status and export of cut-flowers. The unit was also asked to submit the details of export effected by them along with details of prospective buyers.

It was also observed that in any case, the party is not allowed to import further until they achieve the positive NFE. Central Excise Authority took the strong objection for extending the LOP. The Committee directed the party to resubmit the projection details and flow chart before Committee can take a final view in the matter.

4. M/s. Sarla Performance Fibers Ltd.

The representative of the unit informed that there is no excess import of Raw Material in terms of US\$ basis as the value permitted was also in US\$ basis. The committee noted the same and their contention was accepted.

5. M/s. Precision Camshafts Ltd.

The representative of the unit stated that they have submitted letter seeking time for detailed reply. The Committee deferred the proposal.

6. M/s. Worldwide Oilfield Machine Pvt. Ltd

The representative of the unit was asked to submit the detailed justification for excess import and explanation as to why action should not be initiated against them. The matter was deferred.

7. M/s. Magnum Forge & Machine Works Pvt. Ltd.

The representative of the unit was asked to submit the detailed justification for excess import and explanation as to why action should not be initiated against them. The matter was deferred.
