

Record of discussion in the Open House Meeting with Developers and Units of MADC - Mihan Nagpur held under the Chairmanship of Joint Development Commissioner, SEEPZ-SEZ on 08th May, 2015.

Attendance: As per list attached.

The following issues were discussed:-

1. Softex Certification

The Specified Officer and the Authorized officers stated that there is no pendency with regard to certification of Softex Forms.

2. Issue of IEC-Code

The representative of ADCC said that they had applied to the local office of DGFT at Nagpur for issue of IEC-Code. However, they have been advised to approach Development Commissioner's office. Accordingly they have applied to the Development Commissioner's office and are awaiting grant of IEC-Code.

It was informed that the Development Commissioner's office in response to their application, has asked the unit to apply through SEZ-Online.

After detailed discussion on the issue, the unit representative stated that their registered office is located outside the STP premises. The Assistant DGFT, Nagpur, said that they were under the impression from the unit's correspondence with their office that the registered office of the unit is located in STP premises and therefore they were advised to apply to Development Commissioner, SEEPZ. He stated that the Unit can clarify to the effect that their registered office is located outside STP premises, in which case, the IEC can be granted to them by this office.

3. M/s. Lupin Ltd. extension of utility of LOA.

Representative of M/s. Lupin Ltd. said that their construction activity is held up as their request for validity of extension is pending.

It was informed that this request would require approval of BOA as the extension is for 3rd year without completion of 2/3 of work and accordingly, the request has been submitted to Ministry for consideration of BOA. Considering the urgency expressed by unit, the Development Commissioner, SEEPZ, has written to Ministry to consider granting an interim extension of three months.

The representative of unit further stated that in similar case, in the past, the Indore SEZ has allowed Clarence & utilization of duty material as a temporary arrangement with a condition to keep the material in separate area & maintaining a separate account of utilization. He requested if similar arrangement can be considered by SEEPZ the same would resolve their immediate problem.

It was informed that the details of case would be examined.

4. Mr. Ashish Jagrawat, consultant MADC & representing some of the units wanted to know whether printouts of Shipping bills and Bill of entries taken in legal size page would be accepted instead of A3.

It was clarified that printouts on legal size paper are accepted.
