

Record of discussion in the Open House Meeting with Developers and Units of Pune Zone held under the Chairmanship of Joint Development Commissioner, SEEPZ-SEZ on 27th April, 2015.

Attendance: As per list Attached.

The following issues were discussed:-

1. Members present in the open house raised the issue on clearing of softex by the specified officer.

It was informed that necessary clarification required by the specified officer has already been issued by Development Commissioner Office. The specified officers have stated that all the pending applications will be cleared by 15.05.2015. The unit concerned can bring to the notice of the Development Commissioner Office if there is pending beyond 1505.2015.

[Action: Specified Officer Pune]

2. A representative of Unit from Aurangabad SEZ raised issue on availability of Specified Officer at Aurangabad SEZ and stated the officer should be from local commissionerate.

It was clarified that the request will be examined.

[Action: Specified Officer - SEEPZ]

3. Representative from Infosys raised issue on the application of MPR in SEZ online stating no acknowledgement is generated after filing of the MPR application.

It was informed that NSDL has already been asked to do the needful in this matter so that acknowledgment can be generated on submission of MPR to Development Commissioner Office.

[Action: NSDL]

4. Approval of list of goods in respect of units. Mr. Mundra stated that the SEZ rules provides for approval of list of goods for developers. The requirement of submission of CA certified HPR regarding consumption of goods has also been provided in the case of developers. However, approval of List of goods for units has not been prescribed in SEZ rules whereas in the case of some units approval is granted by UAC. It is necessary to have a uniform procedure.

It was clarified that in respect of units, apart from the details furnished at the time of project application, no separate approval of list of capital goods is required. However approval of construction material will require approval by UAC.

5. Members present in the meeting stated that a separate training should be conducted by NSDL regarding integration of ICEGATE and SEZ Online.

It was informed that for the convenience of units located in Pune region, a separate training for units/developers will be organized at Pune. The date and time will be communicated to the units/developers.

[Action: NSDL]

6. The representative of Syntel stated that online payment facility of duty payment need to be made available as is available at airport

It was informed that the issue will be taken up with NSDL.

[Action: NSDL]

7. Representative of serum stated that in the case of status holder EOUs, the policy permits DTA sale to be made under intimation to Development Commissioner. Whereas Development Commissioner's office is asking for taking prior permission. This takes away the benefits given in the policies.

It was informed that there were certain audit observations to the effect that DTA sale of goods not in accordance with the FTP had taken place. In this context, it has been decided that the status holder units should submit the intimation in the prescribed format for DTA sale so that all relevant details are available with Development Commissioner's office. This requirement in no way takes away the benefit available to status holders as per FTP.

Record of discussion in the Open House Meeting with Developers and Units of Mumbai Zone held under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner, SEEPZ-SEZ on 22nd April, 2015.

Attendance: As per list Attached.

The following issues were discussed:-

1. Representative of M/s. Rank International raised issue on Single window clearance stating under Prime Minister's initiative of "Easy of Doing Business". The Maharashtra State Assembly on April 6, 2015 unanimously passed a bill that allowed industries to do away with the permissions from Civic Bodies in case of expansion or building of new units in Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation (MIDC) area of the State but due to non-presence of Maharashtra SEZ Act, there is no clarity for the units operating in SEZ's in Maharashtra with regards to obtaining licenses from different bodies viz. Factory License, Fire Brigade License, BMC License, MPCB License, etc. in-spite of applying for set-up of a unit in SEZ in "FORM-F" which is a consolidated application for all these license. So as a part of ease of doing business initiative under the Make-in-Maharashtra campaign, could Development Commissioner office request Honorable Chief Minister Shri Devendra Fadnavis to table a similar bill in the Maharashtra Assembly so that units operating in SEZ need not have to apply for license to any other departments expect to your office.

Matter is under examination of state government.

2. Representative of M/s. Rank International raised issue on Permanent Gate Pass stating currently there is a time restriction for applying for issue of Permanent Gate Pass from 10am to 12:30pm. Since this an online application, they should be able to submit it during any time of the day. There could be a cut-off time wherein application submitted after the cut-off time would proceed on the following day. Also, after application submission for knowing the status of whether pass has been approved or rejected, they have to send someone to the pass section and online status as available in the past is no longer available.

Matter is under examination. New procedure is likely to be issued very soon.

3. Representative of M/s. Prosound Products raised issue on building repairs required to the Unit No. 25 SDF - I

It was informed that this being the oldest building in the zone, the conditions of the premises require repairs. Accordingly MIDC has already been asked to carry out necessary repairs.

[Action: MIDC]

4. Members present in the meeting enquired regarding the status of integration of ICEGATE and SEZ-Online.

It was informed that all the queries will be resolved in the training conducted by MSDL regarding integration of ICEGATE and SEZ-Online.
