

Record of Discussions held at SEEPZ-SEZ in the Open House under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner SEEPZ-SEZ, on 08.07.2015.

Attendance: As per list Attached.

The following issues were discussed:-

1. The representative of serum stated that in respect of Star House status holders, the FTP allows DTA sale permission under intimation to DC. whereas the DC's office is asking for obtaining permission which accounts to withdrawal of facility provided in FTP.

The Development Commissioner clarified that the facility of DTA sale under intimation to DC by the Status Holder EOUs as provided in the FTP continues as such. There were instances of misuse of this facility by some EOUs as also audit observations on the issue for effective monitoring. Under these circumstances, the EOUs have been asked by a Public Notice No. 05/2015 of this office to furnish intimation in the prescribed form given in the HBP so that verification of the details can be possible. This requirement in no way takes away the facility of self clearance provided under the FTP. Issue of aforesaid Public Notice has also been brought to the notice of ministry by this office.

2. MMTC raised issues such as difficulties in handling heavy weight parcel/ consignments, last minutes depositing of export consignments by some units which causes delay in completion of requisite procedures, storage of confiscated/detained parcels and certain dues to MMTC from debonded Units, etc.

The DC informed that the MMTC to discuss their difficulties with DC's office, so that keeping in view the need for export facilitation, arrangement could be made.

3. The representative of M/s. iGate Global solutions Ltd. raised issues pertaining to maintenance/repairs of SDFII, SDFV and SDFVII.

Deputy engineer informed that tender for water proofing is being finalized for various buildings and once the approval is obtained from competent authority, the work will commence. The DC observed that water proofing work in any case is a long term solution and will take some time. As a immediate short term solution, the MIDC should examine what can be done to prevent the leakage.

[Action: MIDC]

4. The representative of e-Emphasys Systems Pvt. Ltd. stated that the procedure for night shift permissions is cumbersome. Often they are not able to know before 5 P.M. which employees are required to attend the night duty. They stated that obtaining approval on each day is time consuming

The Development Commissioner clarified that as per the procedures set out in Circular No. 2 dated 29.04.2015, only intimation to the Security Officer and that the concerned employee attending night duty to sign the register at the entry gate at times of entry, are the requirements specified. There is no need for any approval.
