

**Record of Discussions held at SEEPZ-SEZ in the Open House under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner SEEPZ-SEZ, on 26.09.2014.**

**Attendance:** As per list Attached.

The following issues were discussed:-

1. Letter dated 25.09.2014 of Serene Properties Pvt. Ltd.

**Shri. Amogh Patankar said that after issue of de-bonding approval, the Authorized Officer is seeking submission of invoices etc which they have already furnished at the time of granting No Due Certificate. It was clarified that once De-bonding approval is granted based on No Due Certificate issued by the Specified Officer, there is no need for submission of same documents again.**

**[Action: Specified Officer, Mumbai]**

2. The other issues in the Open House were as following:-

(i) Mr. Vinod Sharma representing M/s. Syntel International Ltd. located in Pune and representatives from M/s. Accenture Services Pvt. Ltd. and M/s. Sterlite Technologies Ltd. requested for process mapping of various standard processes and time line allotted for such processes.

**It was clarified that most of the processes are digitized and also training for the same are conducted by NSDL. Proposed time line for disposal of various processes of work related to SEZ Developers/units has been prescribed by the Ministry and displayed at the DC's Office and also hosted in SEEPZ-SEZ website.**

(ii) Representatives from various Developers/units requested for ease in the procedure of issuance of gate pass.

**It was clarified that the new gate erected for coming to DC's office will be opened, which will resolve the issue.**

(iii) Representative form M/s. Scope chemicals Pvt. Ltd. asked for clarification. If names of the chemicals have not been specified in the ITC (HS) code book or chemicals specified in others category, then can the list of goods be approved and how?

**It was clarified that such requests can be approved but the unit need to furnish proper justification and project report for each category of chemicals.**

(iv) Representative from Arshiya FTWZ requested for separate rule for FTWZ and Ice-gate system integration with online SEZ system.

**It was informed that the matter is under consideration of the Department of Commerce in consultation with Department of Revenue.**
