Reserve Bank of India has developed a comprehensive Centralized IT System called 'Export Data processing and Monitoring System' (EDPMS). Under the new system, the export data will auto flow from primary source (Customs/SEZ/STP) to RBI and thereafter pushed by RBI to the AD Banks for further follow up with exporters. It would ensure enforcement of laws relating to export, reduce duplicate reporting to multiple agencies and improve customer service. It would also ensure effective follow-up of large value transactions/transactions of serious nature. The new system will facilitate the banks to report all the returns through a single platform which would reduce the reporting burden of Authorized Dealer Banks.

The testing of transmission of data between RBI and SEZ (NSDL) has been completed.

In view of above, the following directions are issued:

- (i) Units shall discontinue submission of copies of Shipping Bills & Bills of Entry meant for record of Customs & records of concerned Unit. However, copies of Shipping Bills & Bills of Entry meant for movement of goods from the Unit to Customs Port or vice-versa and for granting 'Let Export Order' or 'Out of Charge', as the case may be, shall be submitted and endorsed as per existing procedure.
- (ii) In case of Bills of Entry, only Duplicate & Exchange Control Copy (i.e. Quadruplicate) shall be required to be submitted.
- (iii) In case of Shipping Bills meant for export from MMTC i.e. those pertaining to Gems & Jewellery, only Duplicate & Triplicate copy shall be required to be submitted &
- (iv) In case Shipping Bills pertaining to export of Non- Gems & Jewellery, apart from Duplicate & Triplicate, Quadruplicate shall also be required to be submitted for endorsement by Gate PO & at Airport.
