PUBLIC NOTICE No.- 06/2026

Subject: Regulation of Examination of Export Consignments in SEEPZ Special Economic Zone – regarding.

Attention of all SEZ Units, Customs Brokers and other stakeholders is invited to the present practice regarding examination of export consignments in SEEPZ Special Economic Zone (SEZ). In this regard, attention is invited to Rule 75 of the Special Economic Zones Rules, 2006 (hereinafter 'the Rules'), which provides as under:

"Unless otherwise specified in these rules, all inward or outward movement of goods into or from the Zone by the Unit or Developer shall be based on self-declaration, and no routine examination of such goods shall be made unless specific orders of the Development Commissioner or the Specified Officer are obtained:

Provided that all the consignments in a Special Economic Zone shall be subject to a Risk Management System."

2. It had been observed that a substantial number of consignments are being selected by the RMS for 100% examination. In this regard, Instruction No. 01/2024 dated 19.07.2024, was issued vide F. No. Eoffice-Cust-11/2/2023-Custom, which prescribed waiver of examination orders given by ICEGATE RMS. Accordingly only about 2–3% of export consignments are physically examined based on local risk assessment.

3. However, it has been also observed that many units are registering export consignments very late. Due to this, there is a delay in processing of the same and hence, units submitting consignments on time are facing problems of offloading of their parcels by the Airline. To encourage timely submission of Consignments for examination and prevent offloading of export consignments of compliant units, it has now been decided that the below procedure shall be followed with immediate effect:-

(i) All export consignments which have been successfully registered for examination on or before 04:30 P.M. on a particular working day shall continue to be governed by the procedure prescribed under the aforesaid Instruction No. 01/2024 dated 19.07.2024, unless a specific direction for examination of such consignment is issued by the Specified Officer/Development Commissioner.

(ii) All export consignments which are registered for examination after 04:30 P.M. on a particular working day shall be subjected to examination as per the RMS instructions. No waiver of RMS instructions shall be given to such consignments.

(iii) The above cut-off time shall be determined with reference to the time at which the consignment is successfully registered for examination in the system, and not merely on the basis of the time of filing or generation of the Shipping Bill number.

(iv) The above procedure shall be without prejudice to the powers of the Specified Officer/Development Commissioner to order examination of any consignment in accordance with Rule 75 of the Rules and other applicable provisions.

4. All SEZ Units, Customs Brokers and other stakeholders are directed to ensure timely registration of consignments. Units may also note and be informed that export consignments registered after 4.30 PM may not be able to be cleared and shipped on the same day.

5. The custodian (DGDC) shall also ensure the timely carting of its vehicles to prevent offloading of consignments registered within specified time i.e., 4.30 PM.

6. Difficulties, if any, in the implementation of this Public Notice may be brought to the notice of the Office of the undersigned. The decisions contained in this Public Notice shall be treated as a Standing Order for the purpose of officers and staff of this Zone
